





#### DO AT LEAST 3 TEAM BUILDING INTERVIEWS **EVERY WEEK.**

The best way to qualify a potential team member is through team building interview. Get to know what motivates her and introduce the opportunity according to her motivation.



#### DO AT LEAST 3 CUSTOMER SERVICE ACTIVITIES **EVERY WEEK.**

Get products to your customers quickly and place it in a beautiful paper bag with samplers inside. You may follow Mary Kay Ash's 2+2+2 system (follow up in 2 days, 2 weeks and 2 months). It's tried and tested, and it works. Follow up using whatever method your customers prefer a call, text or email



"ON DOING CUSTOMER SERVICE ACTIVITIES: I make sure that my customers are not just one-time buyers. After trying and using Mary Kay products, I would send them an SMS message or a Facebook message to hear their feedbacks. Then, a few weeks or months later, I would do follow up orders by texting or emailing them.
